School will now be closed through Friday, May 1 as per the Governor's most recent waiver and executive order on Thursday, March 19. In addition, the Governor has cancelled all standardized tests for this year. Every day that school is closed will **not** be made up at a later date.

The school district will have three eLearning days per week beginning on April 14 through April 30. However, eLearning days will be considered as regular school days in which attendance and grades will be recorded. The eLearning days will be on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of each week through the date of April 30, 2020. In the near future, you will be receiving information from your principal on communication procedures for eLearning days. If you have additional questions, you can call your building office during regular school hours.

All eLearning days through May 1 will be based on lessons and educational opportunities (curriculum) through digital devices for students in grades K through 12. The plan to distribute the elementary devices will be announced next week and emailed and posted on our website.

Also, we will continue the food distribution program on Mondays through the end of April and hopefully as long as school is closed for this emergency. Continue to register online for the food distribution. If you cannot register digitally or cannot pick up at the designated times, then please call Amanda Worrick at 674-8528


If school would be closed beyond the date of May 1, we will continue to provide you the school's communication regarding eLearning days, food distribution, graduation information, and digital learning opportunities for this summer. We will continue to communicate with you by phone, email and our website.

I know these are anxious and troublesome times. It is very important that we continue to practice good hygiene and the recommended practices to prevent the spread of this virus. If we wash our hands frequently, if we practice social distancing consistently, and if we are respectful and caring for each other, then we will get through this crisis together!
